

Scott's Distributing Pest Control Procedure

Purpose:

Provide operator with clear, safe operating instructions for carrying out inspection, sanitation and pest control procedures and corrective action guidelines for out of control operations.

Scope:

Pest control procedures including; warehouse sanitation, setting up outside bait stations and procedures for out of standard situations.

Responsibilities:

It is the responsibility of Warehouse and Operations Management to insure that this procedure is implemented. Licensed Pest Control Operators are responsible for following and updating these procedures as required. Warehouse personnel are responsible for implementing daily/weekly sanitation and cleaning procedures. Operation's is responsible for re-certifying these procedures after annual reissue or after changes are made.

The purpose of the outside bait stations is to prevent infestation of the warehouse by rodents

1. Outside bait stations are used and checked once a month.
2. All data is recorded in Pest Control Report
3. A map of bait stations is on file
4. Quintox mouse seeds are used at the rate of one to four (10 gram) packets per station. **(EPA Reg. No. 12455-57)**
5. Rodenticide usage is recorded in the Pesticide Log.

The purpose of the inside rodent device traps is to catch any rodents that may have entered the warehouse and to eliminate any rodent presence in the warehouse.

1. Inside rodent device traps are set along likely routes of rodent travel
2. Device traps are checked daily
3. All data is recorded on the Pest Control report
4. A map of station locations is on file

NOTE: No pesticide is stored in the warehouse
